

Project Mishram



Project Mishram or simply **MishraM** is a ‘seven’ piece Progressive Carnatic fusion band from Bangalore, India. Mishram’s is an amalgamation of the western genres of music like Rock, Metal, Jazz, Reggae and Electronic music centered around the Indian classical music. In Sanskrit, Mishram means ‘Mix’ and also denotes the number ‘Seven’. The band was formed in 2015, by a group of seven talented youngsters and budding musicians who pushed the boundaries and believed in creating a unique style of infusing Indian classical elements within western music.

Two years on the competition circuit, playing at open-mic nights, live music bars, and inter-collegiate festivals winning over 35+ 'Battle of bands' events and an inspired outlook on Carnatic fusion later, Project Mishram has been performing across the country and abroad at prestigious venues and has won several awards and recognition. With three successful international concert tours (2019, 2022 and 2023), Mishram has played over 30 shows overseas at the ArcTangent Festival-2023, twice at the prestigious UK Tech Fest, alongside some of the biggest progressive metal bands like Monuments, The Ocean Collective, God is an astronaut, Vildhjarta, and Leprous, South Asian Heritage Festival-2023 to name a few.

The band has bagged several accolades throughout the journey such as Yamaha Swagbash (2017), Maruti Suzuki-Colours of Youth-Season 7 (2018), a reality show for entertainment acts across the country judged by Benny Dayal, Shakti Mohan, Neeti Mohan, and Soha Ali Khan at which a brand new Maruti Suzuki-Vitara Brezza was gifted to the winners of the show.

In India, the band has performed at prominent music festivals and live music venues including at Music Mojo on Kappa TV, Nat Geo Wild's 'Echoes of Earth festival-2019', TEDx NitteDU and Hyderabad, Strawberry Fields festival to name a few.

Project Mishram has had the privilege to open for stalwarts in the Indian film and music industry such as Sid Sriram and Shaan at IIT Madras, Sunidhi Chauhan at XIM Bhubhaneshwar, Benny Dayal at IIM Bangalore, Thaikkudam Bridge at IISc Bangalore, Anushka Manchanda at RVCE, The Local train at NIT Surathkal, UnderSide (Nepal) and Modern Day Babylon (Czech Republic). During the pandemic, Project Mishram was one of the very few band chosen to perform at HCL SoundScapes, online concert series which garnered over 1 million views. Other artists featured in this series include Harshdeep Kaur, Kavita Seth, and Mame Khan. Many other corporate entities have organized concerts, sponsored tours, and have supported the band including TEDx, Air India, Maruti Suzuki NEXA, Monster Energy and Fab India. The band was invited to perform twice at the High Commission of India in London, United Kingdom.

Several noted music magazines and critics have reviewed and featured the band including Rolling Stone, ProgSpace in addition to regular articles in Indian news media. Project Mishram has around 5 singles and an album 'Meso' featuring several acclaimed musicians from around the world including Rajesh Vaidya, KMac2021, Arun Luthra. Project Mishram and the album 'Meso' were longlisted in the voting ballots for the 'Best New Artist' and 'Best Album of the year' categories for the Grammy awards-2022. The album was also nominated as the 'Best debut album' by Progspace Awards 2021.

More recently, the band was invited to perform at the Tag der offenen Tür (Open day celebrations) at German Foriegn Office and at Kultur Sommerfestival 2023 in Berlin, by the Embassy of India in Germany. Project Mishram also performed a special independence day concert at the Embassy of India in Vienna on 15th Aug 2023. The band has also performed in Spain, Italy and Slovenia.
